The Titration exhibition series reflects the fluid properties of its name in the figurative sense: our changing community, Dublin's growing collection of public art and Dublin's sense of cultural identity.

The community will vote to guide Dublin Arts Council (DAC) in the selection of one or more of the sculptures to acquire as permanent installations in the city.
